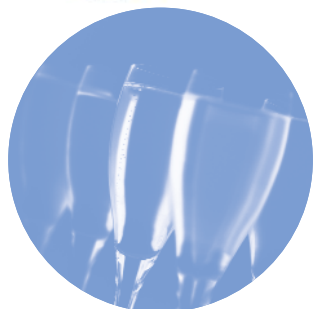


## Rosé Wines

- 14 *Whispering Hills White Zinfandel, California, USA* £12.00  
175ml £2.95  
*Beautiful salmon-pink with loads of fresh summer-fruit flavours and lively acidity.*
- 15 *Pinot Grigio Rosato del Veneto, Collezione Marchesini, Italy* £13.95  
*Dry and subtly raspberry.*

## Sparkling Wine & Champagne

- 23 *Codorniu Clasico 1872 Brut, Cava Spain* £13.45  
*Classic, dry, sparkling wine from the traditional Spanish varieties of Parellada, Xarel-lo and Macabeo.*
- 24 *Berri Estates Cuvée Brut, SE Australia, Australia* £16.45  
*Soft and sparkling with a lively effervescence, a perfect combination of fruit and acidity.*
- 25 *Berri Estates Brut Rosé, SE Australia, Australia* £17.45  
*Soft, luscious, crisp.*
- 26 *Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial Champagne* £33.00  
*Flowery aroma, a long, biscuity flavour and good level of acidity.*
- 27 *Piper-Heidsieck Brut Champagne* £28.00  
*Young, lively fruit flavours and a fresh, vivid aroma.*



## White Wines

- 1 *Whispering Hills Chardonnay, California, USA* £12.00  
175ml £3.10  
*Crisp, lemony and unoaked with ripe tropical fruit flavours and excellent mouthfeel.*
- 2 *Corte Vigna Pinot Grigio, Provincia di Pavia, Italy* £12.50  
175ml £3.40  
*Floral, racy and dry and crisp.*
- 3 *Hardys 'The Riddle' Riesling-Gewürztraminer, SE Australia, Australia* £13.00  
175ml £3.70  
*Off-dry with tropical fruit and lychee characters.*
- 7 *Etchart Privado Torrontes-Chardonnay, Salta Argentina* £13.45  
*Grapey and aromatic using the unusual Torrontes with its exotic lychee and spicy character.*
- 8 *Petit Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils France* £20.45  
*Dry, steely and elegant with underlying Chardonnay fruit.*
- 9 *Valle Andino Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile* £14.45  
*Crisp and dry with a distinctive gooseberry flavour.*
- 10 *Cullinan View Chenin Blanc, Robertson, South Africa* £13.45  
*Light and fresh, creamy and round, with a peachy fruit flavour.*
- 11 *Fortius Blanco, Navarra Spain* £14.45  
*Cool fermented Chardonnay and Viura produce this crisp, fresh, fruity wine.*
- 12 *Pinot Grigio delle Venezia Giulia Lumina, Ruffino, Italy* £16.00  
*Fresh dry pear and apple.*
- 13 *Nobilo Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough New Zealand* £17.95  
*Crisp and dry with tropical fruit and a hint of grassy complexity.*

## Red Wines

- 4 *Whispering Hills Merlot, California USA* £12.00  
175ml £3.10  
*Typically soft and juicy with ripe berry fruit flavours and supple tannins.*
- 5 *Condesa de Leganza Crianza, La Mancha, Spain* £12.50  
175ml £3.40  
*Full-bodied with ripe fruit and vanilla hints on the palate.*
- 6 *Hardys 'The Riddle' Shiraz-Cabernet, SE Australia Australia* £13.00  
175ml £3.70  
*Spicy pepper, raspberry, cherry fruit, blackcurrant, capsicum and mint.*
- 16 *Don Jacobo Crianza Rioja Tinto, Bodegas Corral, Spain* £16.45  
*Good structure, appealing soft fruit and traditional oaky character.*
- 17 *Chianti, Trambusti Italy* £13.45  
*Good, typical Chianti in the traditional straw 'fiasco'.*
- 18 *Valle Andino Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley, Chile* £14.45  
*Vibrant coloured and fruit-driven with ripe, juicy fruit.*
- 19 *Cullinan View Pinotage, Robertson South Africa* £15.00  
*Rich, full and spicy with attractive fruit aromas and flavours.*
- 20 *Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Marie-Louise Parisot, France* £14.50  
*Ripe velvety wild cherry and strawberry.*
- 21 *Etchart Privado Malbec, Valle de Cafayate, Argentina* £15.00  
*Deep coloured with an aroma reminiscent of raisins, plum and black pepper, and a palate which is well structured yet supple on the finish.*
- 22 *Blackstone Merlot, California USA* £18.45  
*Dark cherry and berry and a touch of clove.*
